### Burglary: 2

- St. Attracta Road -9<sup>th</sup> July 2019 Approx. 01:30am. Occupants in the house heard noise downstairs, observed a number of males leaving the scene in both of the occupants vehicles. Scene has been examined and enquiries on-going.
- St. Fassaugh Road 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019 between 14:45pm and 16:45pm, occupant returned home to find blinds pulled down and cupboards in the house emptied out. Upstairs rear window was open and believed the offender made their exit through this window. Subsequent amount of cash and iPad taken. Scene technically examined. Enquiries on-going.

### Criminal Damage: 3

- Quarry Road – 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 01:20am. Offender threw a flower pot at the door of property while trying to gain access, causing damage to the door. Male arrested at scene.
- St. Attracta Road – 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 between 12am and 05:30am. Damage caused to front door of property overnight.
- St. Jarleth Road – between the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Eggs thrown on a vehicle which was parked outside the owner's house.

### Theft (from MPV): 3

- Annaly Road – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2019. Vehicle left unlocked overnight, tools taken, no damage to vehicle.
- Fassaugh Road – 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Owner of vehicle left it parked unlocked overnight. Mobile phone taken.
- Quarry Road – 4<sup>th</sup> September 2019. While injured party was carrying money into the casino, vehicle was left unlocked, male broke passenger side window and took a bag of coins.

### **Theft from person: 1**

- Bregia Road – 9<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 19:20pm. Female reported that while walking along the road a male cycled up behind her and removed her headphones from her head and cycled away. No force was used or injury sustained.  
The injured party observed the offender just before incident on the Luas travelling from Westmorland Street to Cabra along with a second male who was also present at the time of the theft. Both males described as approx. 18yrs old, white and Irish, male who took the headphones was wearing a black puff style jacket.

### **Unauthorised taking:**

### **Robbery:**

- Homestead Court – 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019. Allegation of assault, connected to ongoing dispute between neighbours.
- St. Eithna Road – 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at 17:20pm. Injured party observed two males acting suspicious in the area, when he confronted the males, they became aggressive towards him with some pushing and shoving, both males then left the area.
- Leix Road – 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019 02:00am. Domestic between a couple, both were highly intoxicated.
