1. Garda Report

1. Speeding on Ashtown Road & over Longford Bridge
2. Parking on 'Keep Clear' at Douglas & Kaldi Café

2. Dublin City Council Report

A) Traffic

1. Request for parking spaces to be lined outside shops at Ashtown Grove.
2. Yield markings needed on road as you exit Glenarrif Road onto Glenbrook Road (same as recently painted Yield markings from Park Road to Ashtown Grove)
3. Bike stands needed at space at each end of the shops on Kinvara Park (Mace etc).
4. Previous request for Yellow Box at Villa Park Road, Dublin 7
5. Kinvara Park - Upgrade parking at shops on Kinvara Park to allow parallel parking and cut down on traffic disruption at this location.

B) Parks

1. Can the grass in the swales in Glendhu Park and Park Road be cut more frequently?
2. The Navan Road area - Clearing of weeds on kerbs/gullies needed throughout the area
3. Tree pruning request for tree opposite no. 29 Kinvara Road.

C) Public Domain

1. Kinvara Ave - Green Box at the entrance is rotting and needs to be replaced.
2. Kinvara Avenue - Litter Bin burnt out and needs to be replaced.
3. Ashtown Grove - Planting of the Container outside the Spar Shop on Ashtown Grove.
4. Ashtown Grove - Recycling Bins beside Post Office. Request for cameras.
5. Red Dog Waste Bins at entrances to Martin Savage Park and Glendhu Park need to be emptied on a regular basis. They are currently overflowing.

D) Road Maintenance

1. Footpath behind lamp post no.6 on Glendhu road which is in a dangerous condition.
2. Glenbrook Road - The footpath raised from tree.
3. Footpaths at Kinvara Park Shops are all broken up outside the houses at each end of the entrance to the shops - Policing Forum September 2018.
4. Lump missing from footpath outside 41, Glenbrook Road (right hand side going into Glendhu Road) PF September 2018
5. Lump out of footpath on Park Road alongside the green. Also this footpath is sinking and edges in bad repair
6. Footpath in Martin Savage Park pitches at the junction with the footpath to Plunketts floods during heavy rain which makes the path impassable.
